BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On August 24, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling Technical Conference and Denying Motion for Evidentiary Hearing (Technical Conference Order), in the above-captioned docket. The Technical Conference Order, among other things, scheduled an in-person technical conference for September 30 and October 1, 2021, identified three main topics to be discussed, and designated several parties as presenters of information.

Based on recent developments surrounding the COVID pandemic the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to change the technical conference from an in-person conference to a remotely held conference, and to require that all participants prefile certain information and documents, as specified below.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That the technical conference shall be conducted remotely via Webex on the dates and at the time stated in the Technical Conference Order;
2. That on or before September 21, 2021, the attorneys for the parties shall provide the name, phone number, and email address of the person who will be attending the conference.
