The North Carolina Attorney General, through the undersigned, moves for an extension of time in which to serve Appellants' proposed record on appeal on

other parties in accordance with Rules 18(d)(2) and (f) and 27(c) of the North Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure in the above-captioned matter. In support thereof, the Attorney General states the following:

- 1. On 20 July 2018, the Attorney General filed notice of appeal and exceptions to the 22 June 2018 Order in this proceeding pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-90(a). On 23 July 2018, the North Carolina Justice Center, North Carolina Housing Coalition, Natural Resources Defense Council, and Southern Alliance for Clean Energy ("N.C. Justice et al.") jointly filed notice of appeal. On that same date, the Sierra Club and the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association ("NCSEA") filed notices of appeal. All were timely. On 8 August 2018, the Public Staff-North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Public Staff") filed a timely notice of cross appeal.
- 2. The current deadline for the Attorney General to serve the proposed record on appeal is Friday, 24 August 2018. The deadline may be extended by the Commission for up to thirty days pursuant to Rules 18(f) and 27(c) (1). Due to other workload of the attorneys involved in the case, the complexity of the issues, the many parties, and the large record, additional time is required to prepare and serve the proposed record, and the Attorney General requests an additional 30 days to and including Monday, 24 September 2018 for any party to serve the proposed record.
- 3. The undersigned have communicated with counsel for Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, Sierra Club, N.C. Justice, et al., NCSEA, and the Public Staff who stated that they do not object to the requested extension. Further,

other intervenors were contacted by email and did not respond with an objection to the requested extension.

Wherefore, the North Carolina Attorney General respectfully requests an extension of an additional 30 days, up to and including Monday 24 September 2018, in which to serve the proposed record on appeal on other parties in this proceeding.
