I understand that this department approved several rate adjustments better know as storm recovery costs and Summary of Rider adjustments. There were "4" storm recovery costs and "5" Summary of Rider adjustments totaling 59.40 plus 4.16 in tax that was charged on these adjustments for a total of 63.56. My total bill for the month was 300.65. So, the adjustments made up 21.15% of my bill. This, on top of the approximately 10% increase Duke was allowed this year.
