BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On May 7, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Requiring Further Additional Testimony that required the Public Staff to file testimony and exhibits addressing five questions and the testimony of Pitt Solar, LLC (Pitt Solar), on or before June 29, 2021. The Public Staff requested an extension to July 7, 2021, to file its supplemental comments, to which Pitt Solar LLC consented. The Commission issued an Order on June 20, 2021, that granted the Public Staff's requested extension and required that Pitt Solar's reply testimony be filed by July 21, 2021.

On July 21, 2021, Pitt Solar filed a Motion for Extension of Time, requesting that the deadline for its reply testimony be extended to July 23, 2021. In the motion, Pitt Solar states that it needs the additional time to finalize its reply testimony.

Pitt Solar also states in the motion that the Public Staff does not object to the requested extension.

After careful consideration, the Presiding Commisioner finds good cause to grant the motion and to extend the date for Pitt Solar to file its reply testimony to July 23, 2021.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
