BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On January 12, 2018, the Commission issued in the above-captioned proceeding an Order granting, subject to certain conditions, a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Convenience and Necessity to Duke Energy Progress, LLC for the construction of approximately 11.5 miles of new 230-kilovolt transmission line in Johnston and Wake Counties, North Carolina.

On February 7, 2018, Oliver L. Canaday, an intervening party to this proceeding, filed a Motion for Extension of Time, requesting that the Commission extend the time within which to file a notice of appeal and exceptions to the Commission's January 12, 2018 Order, from February 12, 2018, to March 14, 2018.

On February 8, 2018, the Commission issued an Order Granting Extension of Time to File Notice of Appeal and Exceptions to the Commission's January 12, 2018 Order until March 14, 2018.

On March 13, 2018, Mr. Canaday filed a Motion for Reconsideration of the Commission's January 12, 2018 Order.

The Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to allow Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and the Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission an opportunity to file responses to Mr. Canaday's Motion for Reconsideration, and for Mr. Canaday to file a reply.

## IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and the Public Staff North Carolina Utilities Commission may file responses to Mr. Canaday's Motion for Reconsideration on or before Friday, March 30, 2018; and
  - 2. That Mr. Canaday may file a reply no later than Monday, April 9, 2018.
