BY THE COMMISSION: On December 31, 2014, in Docket No. ER-39, Sub 0, the Commission issued an Order Granting Certificate of Authority (Certificate) to Breckenridge Group Charlotte North Carolina, LLC, to resell electric services at Aspen Charlotte, located at 1315 E WT Harris Boulevard, Charlotte, North Carolina 28213, in accordance with G.S. 62-110(h) and Commission Rule R22.

On March 13, 2015, Breckenridge Group Charlotte North Carolina, LLC, and Breckenridge Group CNC, LLC (Breckenridge Group CNC or Applicant), filed an application with the Commission in Docket Nos. ER-39, Sub 1 and ER-55, Sub 0 requesting that the Commission transfer the certificate of authority to resell electric service from Breckenridge Group Charlotte North Carolina, LLC to Breckenridge Group CNC.

On May 6, 2015, the Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission (Public Staff) filed its correspondence to the Applicant outlining deficiencies in the application.

On May 11, 2015, the Commission issued an Order Finding the Application Incomplete and Request for Additional Information.

On June 25, 2015, and August 06, 2015, the Applicant filed additional information in response to the Public Staff's correspondence of May 6, 2015.

On August 17, 2015, the Public Staff filed a letter with the Commission indicating that the application remained incomplete based upon additional information submitted by the Applicant.

On August 27, 2015, the Applicant filed additional information in response to the Public Staff's correspondence of August 17, 2015.

On October 21, 2015, the Public Staff filed correspondence with the Commission stating that the application was incomplete due to remaining deficiencies.

On November 23, 2015, the Applicant filed additional information in response to the Public Staff's correspondence of October 21, 2015.

On January 20, 2016, the Public Staff filed a letter with the Commission outlining remaining deficiencies in the application.

On February 16, 2016, the Applicant filed a response with attachments addressing the deficiencies listed in the Public Staff's correspondence of January 20, 2016.

On April 18, 2016 and August 3, 2016, the Public Staff filed letters with the Commission outlining remaining deficiencies in the application.

On August 15, 2016, the Applicant filed additional information with attachments in response to the Public Staff's correspondence on April 18, 2016, and August 3, 2016.

On October 4, 2016, the Public Staff filed an email with the Commission listing several remaining deficiencies.

On October 13, 2016, the Applicant filed information with attachments requested in the Public Staff's correspondence of October 4, 2016.

On October 25, 2016, the Public Staff filed a letter with the Commission indicating that in the Public Staff's opinion, the application was complete upon the Applicant's submissions on June 25, 2015, August 6, 2015, August 27, 2015, November 23, 2015, February 16, 2016, August 15, 2016, and October 13, 2016, and that the completed application complies with the requirements of G.S. 62-110(h) and Commission Rule R22.

The Commission has reviewed the additional information filed by the Applicant and finds that Breckenridge Group CNC's application is complete per G.S. 62-110(h) as of October 25, 2016. The Commission further finds that Breckenridge Group CNC, should be granted a certificate of authority to resell electric service in compliance with its certified statements within the application and subsequent filings in this docket.

Based on the foregoing and the record in these dockets, the Commission finds good cause to transfer the certificate of authority to resell electric service from Breckenridge Group Charlotte North Carolina, LLC, to Breckenridge Group CNC, LLC, and issue a new certificate of authority to Breckenridge Group CNC.


IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That the application filed by Breckenridge Group Charlotte North Carolina, LLC, and Breckenridge Group CNC, LLC, to transfer the Certificate of Authority to resell electric service for Aspen Charlotte, 1315 E WT Harris Boulevard, Charlotte, North Carolina 28213, to Breckenridge Group CNC, LLC, shall be, and is hereby granted.
2. That the Chief Clerk shall close Docket Nos. ER-39, Subs 0 and 1.
3. That this Order shall constitute the Certificate of Authority to Resell Electric Service.
