Dear Ms. Dunston:

On January 9, 2024, the Public Staff filed a response to the Commission's January 2, 2024 Order Finding Application Complete and Requiring the Public Staff to Provide Specific Application Data (Order). The Order required the Public Staff to provide the Commission, within five business days, certain application data as provided in five enumerated paragraphs. Since that filing, the Public Staff learned of an error in its response due to conflicting information provided in the Application.

In response to questions 1 and 5, the Public Staff stated that the subdivision of Buffalo Meadows WW had 2 residential customers currently served by A&D Water Service, Inc. (A&D). Based on the review of A&D's 2021 annual report, the number of Buffalo Meadows wastewater customers should be 44 versus 2. While the revenue requirement remains unchanged, the number of Buffalo Meadows wastewater customers should be revised to 44 and the monthly rate impact revised to \$48.38.
