BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONERS: On February 18, 2021, Thadeus B. Culley and Harry Carl Johnson (Movants), filed a joint Motion for Withdrawal and Substitution of Counsel for Vote Solar in each of the above-captioned dockets, pursuant to Commission Rule R1-7 and Rule 1.16 of the North Carolina State Bar Rules of Professional Conduct. Movants requested that the Commission enter an order allowing Mr. Culley to withdraw from serving as the attorney of record on behalf of Vote Solar, and substituting Mr. Johnson as counsel for Vote Solar. In summary, Movants stated that Mr. Culley will begin new employment on March 1, 2021, that the Motion was filed with the consent and at the direction of Vote Solar, that Mr. Johnson is an attorney in good standing with the North Carolina State Bar, and that Mr. Johnson consents to electronic service of documents pursuant to Commission Rule R1-39.

After careful consideration, the Presiding Commissioners find that there is justifiable cause to grant the Motions.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Thadeus B. Culley is allowed to withdraw as counsel for Vote Solar, and Harry Carl Johnson is substituted as counsel for Vote Solar in the above-captioned dockets.
