Commissioner Floyd McKissick Jr., and I've been assigned to preside over this hearing. With me this morning is Commissioner Kimberly Duffley. Commissioner Hughes may be joining us, but he's not joined us at this time.

I now call for hearing Docket No. G-40, Sub 163, In the Matter of an Application of Frontier Natural Gas Company, hereafter, Frontier for Annual Review of Gas Costs Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 62-133.4(c) and Commission Rule R1-17(k)(6).

The purpose of the review is to compare Frontier's prudently incurred costs with the gas costs recovered from its customers served during the test period in compliance with Rule R1-17(k)(6).

On February 14th, 2022, the Public Staff filed testimony and exhibits of three expert witnesses. No other parties intervened or filed testimony in this docket.

On February 16th, 2022, Frontier and the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that their expert witnesses be excused from attending the hearing. They stated that they had agreed to waive cross-examination of each other's witnesses and had agreed to the introduction of the witnesses' prefiled testimony and exhibits into evidence.

On February 23rd, 2022, the Commission issued an Order excusing expert witnesses, accepting testimony and exhibits, and requiring Proposed Orders. That Order also stated today's hearing will be for the sole purpose of taking the testimony of public witnesses, and that representatives of Frontier and the Public Staff were not required to attend the hearing.

On February 24th, 2022, Frontier filed

affidavits of publication evidencing the newspaper publication of a public notice of today's hearing as required by the Commission.
