BY THE CHAIRMAN: On February 6, 2019, the Commission issued an Order Requesting Comments in the above-captioned dockets. The Order, among other things, set June 7, 2019, and July 10, 2019, as the dates for parties to file comments and reply comments, respectively, regarding the demand-side management and energy efficiency (DSM/EE) mechanisms by which Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (collectively, Duke) recover their DSM/EE costs and incentives.

On May 30, 2019, the North Carolina Attorney General's Office (AGO), filed a motion requesting that the dates for comments and reply comments be extended to July 10, 2019, and August 7, 2019, respectively. The AGO stated that it has contracted with a consulting firm to assist the AGO in reviewing Duke's DSM/EE mechanisms, and that it needs additional time to complete the review and prepare its comments. In addition, the AGO stated that it has contacted all parties about its requested extension of time, and that Duke, the Public Staff and several others parties responded that they do not object to the request. Further, the AGO stated that the remaining parties did not respond to its inquiry.

Based on the AGO's motion and the record, the Chairman finds good cause to extend to July 10, 2019, the date for parties to file initial comments on Duke's DSM/EE mechanisms, and to extend to August 7, 2019, the date for parties to file reply comments.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
