BY THE CHAIR: On October 12, 2021, the Commission issued an order granting Filo Solar, LLC (Applicant) a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) and for its 80 MW_{AC} solar photovoltaic (PV) electric generating facility which had previously been registered as a new renewable energy facility pursuant to Commission Rule R8-66.

On June 26, 2023, the Commission issued an order amending the CPCN for a 70 MW_{AC} solar PV electric generating facility and extending the CPCN for five years.

On March 20, 2024, the Applicant filed a letter requesting that the Commission cancel the registration of the facility.

Based upon the foregoing and the entire record herein, the Chair finds good cause to cancel the registration of the facility as a new renewable energy facility, to close this docket, and to direct the Chief Clerk to deliver a copy of this Order to the NC-RETS Administrator.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
