BY THE CHAIR: On April 26, 2023, the Commission issued an Order Approving Partial Settlement Agreement and Stipulation, Deciding Contested Issues, Granting Partial Rate Increase, Approving Water and Sewer Investment Plan, and Requiring Customer Notice (Rate Order) in the above-referenced proceeding. Among other things, the Rate Order required that the Public Staff and Carolina Water Service Inc. of North Carolina (CWSNC) jointly file Schedules of Rates, applicable Notices to Customers, and Schedules of Connection fees for CWSNC's Base Case, and Schedules of Rates and applicable Customer Notices for WSIP Rate Year 1, WSIP Rate Year 2, and WSIP Rate Year 3.

On May 3, 2023, CWSNC and the Public Staff jointly filed with the Commission, as appendices to its filing, the applicable Schedules of Rates and Connection Fees and Notices to Customers. On May 12, 2023, the Commission issued an Order Approving Schedules of Rates, Schedules of Connection Fees, and Customer Notices (May 12 Order).¹

The May 12 Order requires that at least 30 days prior to the implementation of rates effective for Rate Year 2, CWSNC shall provide notice to customers of rates to be implemented as of April 1, 2024, through March 31, 2025. Due to tariff revisions resulting from changes in rates imposed by third-party suppliers of purchased water or sewer service for certain CWSNC service areas, on February 16, 2024, CWSNC submitted for Commission approval, revised Year 2 Customer Notices reflecting these changes as previously noticed to applicable customers.

Based upon the foregoing, and the entire record, the Chair concludes that good cause exists to approve the revised Notices to Customers attached to this Order.
