Dear Clerk Mount:

This filing is an amendment to the application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) in the above-referenced docket. Albemarle Beach Solar, LLC (the “Applicant”) hereby notifies the Commission that the proposed location of the Facility in the above referenced docket has been modified.

In the initial application dated September 21, 2015, the Applicant sought a CPCN to construct an 80 MW (AC) solar facility located on both sides of Mackeys Road and Albemarle Beach Road in Roper, Washington County, North Carolina. The map from the original application is attached as Exhibit A.

The Applicant hereby requests that the CPCN be amended to remove parcels of land located on the north side of Mackeys Road and on Albemarle Beach Road as outlined in Exhibit B hereto. In addition, an additional parcel was added on the southeast side of Mackeys Road as outlined in Exhibit C hereto. The revised site layout consisting of the total parcels is attached as Exhibit D. All other information in the initial CPCN Application remains the same.

Therefore, Albemarle Beach Solar, LLC respectively request that the Commission amend the CPCN under Docket No. SP-6476 Sub 0 to reflect the revised site layout.


