On June 9, 2020, Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), filed applications for adjustments to the annual cost recovery riders in the following proceedings:

- Docket No. E-2, Sub 1251 Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard (REPS)
- Docket No. E-2, Sub 1252 Demand-Side Management and Energy Efficiency (DSM/EE)
- Docket No. E-2, Sub 1253 Joint Agency Asset Rider (JAAR)
- Docket No. E-2, Sub 1254 Competitive Procurement of Renewable Energy (CPRE) Program

Additionally, the Commission's Order provides that on or before Tuesday, September 1, 2020, all parties shall: (1) file a statement consenting to holding the expert witness hearings by remote means, or a statement objecting to same; and (2) shall send the email addresses of the attorneys, witnesses, and other persons that will participate in the hearings on the party's behalf to the email address provided.

Pursuant to paragraph (1) of the Scheduling Order, the Public Staff hereby states its consent to holding the expert witness hearing by remote means in each of the above-listed proceedings. The Public Staff will submit the email addresses of the attorneys, witnesses, and other persons that will participate in the hearings on behalf of the Public Staff in each proceeding on or before Tuesday, September 1, 2020, pursuant to paragraph (2) of the Scheduling Order.
