BY THE CHAIR: On August 16, 2022, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), filed an application in the above-captioned docket for approval of its proposed Electric Vehicle Load Control Service Pilot (Vehicle-to-Grid) pilot program.

In response to a motion by the Public Staff, on September 16, 2022, the Commission issued an Order extending the date for interested parties to file a protest, petition for intervention or comments regarding the Vehicle-to-Grid pilot program to November 14, 2022. The Public Staff and Vote Solar filed comments on that date.

On November 21, 2022, DEC filed a motion requesting that the date for it to respond be extended to December 12, 2022. DEC stated that it needs additional time to work with the Public Staff on developing a reporting framework, as suggested by the Public Staff in its comments. DEC further stated that Vote Solar and the Public Staff have indicated that they do not object to DEC's motion for extension.

Based on DEC's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to grant the requested extension of time.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that DEC shall file its response on or before December 12, 2022.
