BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On March 18, 2015, the Commission issued an Order scheduling the above-captioned docket for hearing and establishing procedural deadlines. Pursuant to that Order, the testimony of the Public Staff and other intervenors is due on May 18, 2015, and the rebuttal testimony of Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC) is due on May 28, 2015.

On May 18, 2015, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that all intervenors be granted an extension to May 20, 2015, to file testimony, and that DEC be granted an extension to June 1, 2015, to file rebuttal testimony. In support of its motion, the Public Staff states that because of the press of work and other factors the Public Staff needs additional time to complete its testimony. Further, the Public Staff states that DEC and the other parties to this docket, North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association and Carolina Utility Customers Association, Inc., do not object to the Public Staff's motion.

Based on the Public Staff's motion and the record herein, the Presiding Commissioner is of the opinion that good cause exists to grant the Public Staff's motion to extend the due date for all intervenors to file testimony in this docket to May 20, 2015, and to extend the due date for DEC to file rebuttal testimony to June 1, 2015.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
