BY THE CHAIRMAN: On February 2, 2010, the Commission entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with APX Inc. (APX) to develop and administer a renewable energy certificate tracking system for North Carolina, the North Carolina Renewable Energy Tracking System (NC-RETS), which became operational on July 1, 2010. The MOA with APX expires on December 31, 2013, and the Commission intends to initiate discussions with APX as to the terms of a potential extension. Before doing so, the Commission would like to hear from interested NC-RETS users and other stakeholders and solicit their input. To that end, Commission Staff will host a special meeting of stakeholders at 10:30 AM on Tuesday, September 24, 2013, in the Judge Wells Conference Room on the fifth floor of the Dobbs Building, 430 North Salisbury Street, Raleigh.

Stakeholders should plan to come to the meeting prepared to discuss the following questions:

- 1) Has your organization been satisfied with NC-RETS? Have the people at APX with whom you have worked provided satisfactory and professional service and training?
- 2) What, if any, changes to NC-RETS or its terms of use should the Commission consider, and why?
- 3) Given the potential for changes to the statute enacting North Carolina's Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard, including repeal, what additional MOA terms would be prudent for the Commission to consider?

APX personnel will not be present at the meeting so as to encourage frank discussions. Additional details, including a call-in number for those who wish to participate but cannot attend in person, will be posted on the NC-RETS web site. If


