ORDER REQUESTING
REPLY COMMENTS

BY THE CHAIR: On February 4, 2019, the Commission issued an Order in the above-captioned docket initiating a rulemaking on access to electric customer usage data. The Order, among other things, allowed parties to file initial comments and/or proposed rules by April 15, 2019.

At the request of the parties and to facilitate their discussions about proposed rules, the Commission granted extensions of time to file initial comments and/or proposed rules. On February 10, 2020, initial comments were filed by several parties, and proposed rules were filed by the Public Staff, Attorney General's Office, and Mission:data Coalition. In addition, along with its initial comments North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association included a request that the Commission allow the parties to file reply comments on the proposed rules.
