BY THE CHAIR: On August 23, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Requesting Comments in the above-captioned dockets on the request by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (collectively Duke), for approval of their proposed Customer Operated Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE) tariff. Comments were filed by several parties on November 21, 2022. Reply comments are presently due to be filed on or before December 5, 2022.

On November 29, 2022, Duke filed a motion requesting that the Commission extend the time for filing reply comments on the EVSE tariff to January 5, 2023. Duke stated that it is working diligently to review the parties' initial comments and needs an extension of time to complete its review and prepare its reply comments. Duke further stated that it contacted counsel for all parties of record regarding its requested extension of time and that no party has advised that it objects to the extension.

Based on the foregoing and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend to January 5, 2023, the date for all parties to file reply comments on Duke's proposed EVSE tariff.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
