BY THE CHAIR: The above-captioned docket is a rulemaking proceeding on access to electric customer usage data. On October 7, 2022, in response to a motion filed by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (collectively, Duke), the Commission issued an Order extending the date for parties to file supplemental reply comments to December 6, 2022.

On December 6, 2022, the North Carolina Attorney General's Office (AGO), filed a motion requesting an additional extension of time to December 9, 2022, for parties to file supplemental reply comments. In summary, the AGO stated that counsel for the AGO had a family emergency the night before the current deadline for filing supplemental reply comments, that he communicated with counsel for Duke, Dominion Energy North Carolina, Mission:data, and the Public Staff about the requested extension, and that those parties did not object to the requested extension.

Based on the AGO's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend the date for all parties to file supplemental reply comments to December 9, 2022.
