Dear Ms. Campbell:

On October 16, 2019, the Fayetteville Public Works Commission (FPWC) filed in North Carolina Utilities Commission (NCUC) Docket No. SP-12717, Sub 1, a registration statement pursuant to Commission Rule R8-66, seeking registration of an 880-kW AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility (the Facility) located in Fayetteville, Cumberland County, North Carolina, as a new renewable energy. The NCUC approved the registration of the Facility by Order issued April 2, 2020. In the Order, the NCUC stated that FPWC "will be required to participate in the NC-RETS REC tracking system (www.ncrets.org) in order to facilitate the issuance of RECs."

FPWC has been working diligently to establish an account with NC-RETS in order to facilitate the issuance of RECs generated by the Facility that FPWC can accrue and apply towards our annual REPS compliance obligation and retire. In order to allow FPWC to complete the process of establishing such an account with NC-RETS, FPWC asks the NCUC to please either issue an Order or deliver a written communication to NC-RETS identifying FPWC's appropriate reporting status, presumably Qualified Reporting Entity based on informal discussions to date, and directing NC-RETS to establish an account for such a reporting status for FPWC in order to facilitate the issuance of RECs generated by the Facility in compliance with the NC-RETS Operating Procedures.
