BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On December 31, 2019, Aqua North Carolina, Inc. (Aqua), filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to adjust and increase its rates for providing water and sewer utility service in all of its service areas in North Carolina.

On October 26, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Approving Partial Settlement Agreement and Stipulation, Deciding Contested Issues, Granting Partial Rate Increase, and Requiring Customer Notice which continued the Company's Quarterly Earnings, WSIC/SSIC Revenue, and Construction Status Reports.

On November 15, 2022, Aqua filed a request to extend the time to file the Company's Quarterly Earnings, WSIC/SSIC Revenue, and Construction Status Reports for the third calendar quarter of 2022. In its request, Aqua states that the extension of time is necessitated by time constraints resulting from workload difficulties largely related to other cases currently pending before the Commission and normal corporate workload issues. Aqua notes that the Public Staff does not oppose the request.

Based on the foregoing, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to extend the time for Aqua to file the Company's Quarterly Earnings, WSIC/SSIC Revenue, and Construction Status Reports for the third calendar quarter of 2022 until Wednesday, November 30, 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
