NOW COMES THE PUBLIC STAFF – North Carolina Utilities Commission, by and through its Executive Director, Christopher J. Ayers, and respectfully moves that the North Carolina Utilities Commission (Commission) to extend the time to file specific information requested by the Commission in its December 20, 2023, Order in this docket to January 9, 2024. In support of this motion, the Public Staff states the following:

- 1. On August 16, 2023, Currituck Water and Sewer, LLC (Currituck) filed an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and for Approval of Rates (Application) to provide water and sewer utility service to Carolina Village subdivision in Currituck County, North Carolina in accordance with N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-110.
- 2. Currituck filed amendments to its Application on September 20, 2023 and November 14, 2023.

- 3. On December 1, 2023, the Public Staff filed a letter indicating that Currituck did not serve the Public Staff with its November 14, 2023 filing.
- 4. On December 5, 2023, the Commission issued a Second Order Finding Application Incomplete and Request for Additional Information, which required Currituck to serve upon the Public Staff the amended application and confidential exhibit filed in this docket on November 14, 2023.
- 5. On December 14, 2023, Currituck filed a letter certifying that a copy of its amended application was served on the Public Staff on December 5, 2023, and certifying that the confidential portion of the amended application was served upon the Public Staff.
- 6. On December 15, 2023, the Public Staff filed a letter with the Commission indicating that this docket now includes all the information required for a complete application.
- 7. On December 20, 2023, the Commission issued an Order finding Currituck's Application complete and requiring the Public Staff to provide to the Commission, on or before December 29, 2023, answers to five specific questions relating to Currituck's Application (December 20 Order).
- 8. The Public Staff needs additional information from Currituck before it will be able to provide all the information the Commission requested in its December 20 Order and has sent Currituck a data request requesting information that will enable the Public Staff to answer the Commission's questions. The Public Staff expects to receive the information from Currituck during the first week of January 2024.

9. Based on the foregoing, the Public Staff requests an extension of time to provide the information requested by the Commission in its December 20, 2023 Order.

WHEREFORE, the Public Staff requests that the Commission enter an order granting an extension, to and including Tuesday, January 9, 2024, for the Public Staff to file answers to the Commission's questions.
