Duke's proposed change in pricing structure for residential rooftop solar will discourage investment in solar when we should be encouraging it. As an owner of rooftop solar I have followed closely the impact of this proposal and hope the NC Utility Commission will not allow the change.

I understand Duke's estimation of the positive impact on all customers was underestimated. Please pay particular attention to those calculations.

As more people and companies invest in solar, a smaller amount of energy needs to be provided by Duke.
