BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On October 25, 2021, the Commission issued a Notice of Due Date for Proposed Orders and/or Briefs in the above-captioned docket which established that proposed orders and/or briefs are to be filed no later than November 24, 2021. On November 23, 2021, the Public Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time to file proposed orders and/or briefs and further requested an extension of time to file an agreed form of energy efficiency mechanism as contemplated in Paragraph 27 of the Stipulation. The Commission previously issued Orders, on November 9, 2021, and November 19, 2021, extending the date for filing the energy efficiency mechanism.

In support of its motion, the Public Staff states that the Public Staff and Public Service Company of North Carolina, Inc. (PSNC) have worked diligently on a joint proposed order but need additional time to finalize it. The Public Staff also states that it has recently come to the attention of the Public Staff and PSNC that certain excess deferred income tax (EDIT) balances reflected in Settlement Exhibit K need to be corrected. According to the Public Staff, PSNC and the Public Staff are working to verify correct amounts and will need additional time to discuss any changes with the Stipulating Parties and file an amendment to the Stipulation with the Commission. The Public Staff further provides that the Public Staff and PSNC continue to diligently work to finalize the energy efficiency mechanism but anticipate needing more time. The Public Staff represents that the other parties to this proceeding do not object to the request for relief set forth in its Motion for Extension of Time.

Based on the motion and the record, the Presiding Commissioner hereby grants the motion to extend the date for filing proposed orders and/or briefs and the energy efficiency mechanism to Monday, December 6, 2021.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
