BY THE CHAIR: On May 18, 2022, the Commission issued an Order granting the motion of Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP, and collectively with DEC, Duke), for an extension of time to file supplemental comments. Among other things, the Order extended the deadlines for the filing of supplemental comments to Wednesday, June 22, 2022, and for the filing of supplemental reply comments to Thursday, July 7, 2022.

On June 16, 2022, the North Carolina Attorney General's Office (AGO) filed a Motion for Extension of Time. Among other things, the AGO states that it has been working diligently on its supplemental comments but needs more time to review discovery and confer with other parties. The AGO also states that it has contacted counsel for the other parties and no party objects.

Based on the foregoing and the record, the Chair finds good cause to grant the motion and extend the time in which the parties are required or permitted to file supplemental comments updating the comments previously filed in this docket.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That Duke, DENC, and the Public Staff shall file supplemental comments on or before Friday, July 22, 2022;
- 2. That other parties may file supplemental comments on or before Friday, July 22, 2022; and

3. That parties may file supplemental reply comments on or before Monday, August 8, 2022.
