BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On January 22, 2020, Pluris Hampstead, LLC (Pluris Hampstead or the Company), filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to increase its rates for providing sewer utility service in all of its service areas in Pender County, North Carolina. Pluris Hampstead serves approximately 524 residential flatrate sewer customers and 58 metered commercial sewer customers in Pender County, North Carolina.

On February 17, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Establishing General Rate Case and Suspending Rates.

On March 18, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling Hearings, Establishing Discovery Guidelines, and Requiring Customer Notice.

On April 15, 2020, Pluris Hampstead filed an Update to Operating Expenses and Rate Base.

On June 2, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Cancelling the Public Witness Hearing scheduled in the Commission's March 18, 2020 Order.

Pluris Hampstead is proposing to increase the monthly flat rate for residential customers from \$63.95 to \$84.42 and to change the monthly base rate for commercial customers from \$25.24 for all meter sizes to a monthly base rate based on the size of the meter.

In addition, Pluris Hampstead is proposing to increase the commercial customers' commodity charge per 1,000 gallons from \$9.68 to \$16.50.

In March 2020, Governor Roy Cooper issued a progression of Executive Orders that declared a State of Emergency in North Carolina to coordinate response and protective actions to prevent the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19). On May 5, 2020, Governor Cooper issued Executive Order No. 138 easing some restrictions on business operations and mass gatherings, but still limiting face-to-face meetings to no more than ten people and requiring social distancing between individuals of at least six feet.

Based on the record and the current state of uncertainty regarding future requirements to assist in preventing the spread of COVID-19, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to reschedule the expert witness hearing currently scheduled in this docket and to schedule a remote hearing for the purpose of receiving public witness testimony.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That the expert witness hearing currently scheduled for August 4, 2020 is cancelled;
- 2. That the Application is scheduled for expert witness hearing beginning at 2:00 p.m., on Tuesday, September 8, 2020, and continuing as necessary until conclusion. The hearing with be either held remotely via WebEx, or in Commission Hearing Room 2115, Dobbs Building, 430 North Salisbury Street, Raleigh, North Carolina;
- 3. That the Commission will issue an order by August 11, 2020, setting forth the procedures for a remote expert witness hearing or confirming that the expert witness hearing will be held in the Commission Hearing Room;

- That a hearing is scheduled for public witness testimony beginning at 7:00 p.m., on Monday, August 17, 2020, to be held remotely via WebEx. A link to view the hearing will be available at www.ncuc.net. Members of the public that would like to testify must register in advance of the hearing, no later than 5:00 p.m. Public Thursday, August 13, 2020, by contacting Staff the via email PlurisHampsteadPublicHearing@psncuc.nc.gov or by calling 866-380-9816. When registering, provide your name, docket number (W-1305, Sub 12), subdivision in which you are receiving service, telephone number, and the topic of your testimony. Only individuals registered with the Public Staff by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 13, 2020, will be allowed to testify at the public witness hearing;
- 5. The hearing scheduled for Monday, August 17, 2020, shall be for the sole purpose of receiving the testimony of public witnesses. The hearing scheduled for September 8, 2020, shall be for the sole purpose of receiving expert witness testimony from Pluris Hampstead, the Public Staff, and any other parties of record;
- 6. That the Company shall consult with all other parties and file, no later than September 1, 2020, a list of witnesses to be called at the hearing, the order of witnesses, and the estimated time for cross-examination. If the parties cannot agree, the remaining parties shall, no later than September 3, 2020, make a filing indicating their points of disagreement with the Company's filing;
- 7. That Pluris Hampstead is required to file reports addressing all customer service and/or service quality complaints expressed at the public witness hearing, being held via WebEx, on or before August 31, 2020. The Public Staff shall and other intervenors may file supplemental testimony on the subject of the public witness hearing only on or before September 4, 2020; and
- 8. That the Notice to Customers, attached as Appendix A, shall be mailed with sufficient postage or hand delivered by Pluris Hampstead to all affected customers no later than 20 days after the date of this Order; and Pluris Hampstead shall submit to the Commission the attached Certificate of Service properly signed and notarized no later than 30 days after the date of this Order.

However, any rate structure considered will not generate more overall revenues than requested.
