Gen. Stat. § 62-110.8 and discontinue the planning and reporting requirements established by the Commission in Commission Rule R8-71 Subsections (g) and (h) because the CPRE Program procurement implementation phase has concluded (Motion).

Also on September 1, 2023, Duke filed its annual CPRE Program Plan pursuant to Commission Rule R8-71(g) in the above-captioned docket.

Based on the foregoing and the entire record, the Chair finds good cause to solicit comments on Duke's Motion and annual CPRE Program Plan.

- 1. That any person having an interest in this proceeding may file a petition to intervene stating such interest on or before Wednesday, October 11, 2023;
- 2. That parties may file comments responsive to the topics described above by Wednesday, October 11, 2023; and
 - 3. That Duke may file reply comments by Wednesday, October 25, 2023.
