NOW COME Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (collectively, the "Companies"), pursuant to Rule R1-7(a)(5) of the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") and the *Order Allowing Sur-Reply Comments*, issued by the Commission on February 19, 2024, and respectfully move the Commission for a two week extension of time to April 19, 2024, for all parties to file sur-reply comments. In support of their joint motion, the Companies show as follows:

1. On December 9, 2022, the Companies, Dominion Energy North Carolina, the Public Staff, the Attorney General's Office, and Mission:Data filed supplemental reply comments.
2. On February 5, 2024, the Companies filed a joint motion for leave to file sur-reply comments for the purpose of responding to issues raised by parties in their respective supplemental reply comments and proposed rules.
3. On February 19, 2024, the Commission issued an order allowing all parties to file sur-reply comments for the limited purpose of addressing new issues raised in the previously filed supplemental reply comments.

4. Despite their diligent efforts, the Companies require additional time to prepare their sur-reply comments.
5. Counsel for the Companies has contacted counsel for the parties that filed supplemental reply comments in this docket and other parties about this requested extension, and no party objected to it.
6. The requested extension will not result in prejudice to any party.

WHEREFORE, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission issue an order granting an extension of two weeks, up to and including April 19, 2024, for all parties to file supplemental reply comments.
