FILING BRIEFS AND PROPOSED
ORDERS

BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On June 11, 2019, the Commission held a hearing in the above-captioned docket. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Presiding Commissioner granted the Public Staff's request that the evidentiary record be held open until the Public Staff completed its review of data request responses submitted by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), to the Public Staff.

On June 21, 2019, the Public Staff filed a letter stating that it has completed its review of DEC's data request responses, and that it found no material differences between the program costs as filed by DEC and the program costs reflected in the supporting documentation examined by the Public Staff. In addition, the Public Staff stated that its recommended demand-side management and energy efficiency program billing factors are those set forth in the Supplemental Testimony and Exhibits filed on May 28, 2019, by DEC witnesses Carolyn T. Miller and Robert P. Evans.

The transcript of the June 11, 2019 hearing was filed on June 28, 2019.

Based upon the foregoing and the record, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to close the evidentiary record in this docket, and to order that briefs and proposed orders be filed by the parties on or before Monday, July 29, 2019.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
