BY THE CHAIR: On October 5, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Allowing the Filing of Comments, which among other things allowed any North Carolina Low-Income Affordability Collaborative (LIAC) participant to file comments on or before Monday, October 24, 2022, in response to the Joint Final Report and Recommendations (Final Report) filed in the above-captioned dockets.

On October 21, 2022, the North Carolina Justice Center (NCJC), North Carolina Housing Coalition (NCHC), Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC), and Southern Alliance for Clean Energy (SACE; collectively, NCJC et al.) filed a Motion for Extension of Time, requesting a one-week extension of time in which they and other LIAC participants may file comments responsive to the Final Report (Motion). NCJC et al. explain that the press of other business, including abiding by certain deadlines for filings in the Carbon Plan docket, Docket No. E-100, Sub 179, have interfered with completing comments responsive to the Final Report. NCJC et al. further explain that staff transitions have occurred since the LIAC concluded which have also reduced the capacity to complete comments by October 24, 2022.

Based on the foregoing and the record, the Chair concludes that good cause exists to allow the Motion. Any LIAC participant may file comments in response to the Final

Report and its recommendations on or before Monday, October 31, 2022. Reply comments may be filed on or before Monday, November 14, 2022.
