BY THE CHAIR: On July 22, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Consolidating Dockets, Scheduling Hearings, Requiring Filing of Testimony, Establishing Procedural Guidelines, and Requiring Public Notice. In that order, among other actions, the Commission scheduled an expert witness hearing, solely for the purpose of receiving expert witness testimony from the parties in the above-captioned dockets for Wednesday, October 27, 2021, at 10:00 a.m., in the Commission Hearing Room 2115, Dobbs Building, 430 N. Salisbury Street, Raleigh, North Carolina. On October 11, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Remote Procedures for Expert Witness Hearing, which directed that the hearing scheduled for October 27, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. would be conducted remotely via Webex.

On October 15, 2021, Timbermill Wind, LLC (Timbermill) filed a Motion to Cancel Evidentiary Hearing. In the motion, Timbermill stated that the only parties to the dockets are Timbermill and the Public Staff and that no party has filed in opposition to the applications filed in these dockets. Timbermill further states in the motion that the Public Staff does not object to the cancelation of the hearing.

After review of the record, the Chair finds good cause exists to conduct the hearing scheduled for October 27, 2021. The Chair believes that the Commission has questions on the filings that cannot be resolved upon a pre-hearing review of the documents. Therefore, the Timbermill's motion is denied.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
