ORDER ALLOWING PETITION TO INTERVENE

BY THE CHAIRMAN: On March 10, 2008, Carolina Utility Customers Association, Inc. (CUCA), filed a petition to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. The petition states CUCA is an organization of industrial utility customers whose member companies maintain numerous industrial manufacturing facilities and employ thousands of workers throughout the State of North Carolina, including the territory in which Public Service Company of North Carolina, Inc.
