NOW COME Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("Duke Energy Carolinas" or "DEC") and Duke Energy Progress, Inc. ("Duke Energy Progress" or "DEP") (collectively, the "Companies"), and jointly move the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") to grant the Companies an extension of time until Friday, January 31, 2014, to file natural gas hedging reports for DEC and DEP in Docket No. E-100, Sub 47A. In Docket Nos. E-7, Sub 1033 and E-2, Sub 1031, both DEC and DEP, respectively, informed the Commission that the Companies would file natural gas hedging reports in Docket No. E-100, Sub 47A by December 31, 2013. Due to the press of other work, however, the Companies need an extension of time to file their reports.

The Companies have discussed this request for an extension with the parties to Docket Nos. E-7, Sub 1033 and E-2, Sub 1031, and none of the parties object to this request.

WHEREFORE, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC and Duke Energy Progress, Inc. jointly request that the Commission grant the Companies an extension until Friday, January 31, 2014, to file their natural gas hedging reports.
