BY THE CHAIRMAN: On June 14, 2017, Fresh Air XXIV, LLC (Complainant Willoughby PV1), Fresh Air XXIII, LLC,(Complainant East Nash PV1), and Fresh Air XXXVIII, LLC (Complainant Boykin PV1) (collectively, the Complainants) filed a verified Complaint in the above-captioned docket against Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP).

On June 20, 2017, the Commission issued an Order serving the Complaint on DEP and directing DEP to either satisfy the demands of the Complainants and so advise the Commission, or file a response to the Complaints on or before July 20, 2017.

On July 18, 2017, DEP filed a motion for extension of time, requesting that the Commission allow DEP one additional week to satisfy the demands of the Complainants or to respond to the Complainant. In support of its motion, DEP states that the Complaint is complex in nature and requires significant time to review and analyze, and that DEP has worked diligently toward preparing its answer; however the press of other business has delayed completion of the filing. In addition, DEP states that the additional time will allow counsel for DEP to engage in discussions with counsel for the Complainants on the matters set forth in the Complaint. Finally, DEP states that counsel for the Complaints has authorized DEP to state that the Complainants do not oppose the requested extension.


The Chairman finds good cause to grant DEP's motion for extension of time and to set July 27, 2017, as the deadline for DEP to either satisfy the demands of the Complainants and so advise the Commission, or file a response to the Complaint.
