Dear Ms. Campbell:

Virginia Electric and Power Company, d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina (“DENC” or the “Company”), hereby notifies the North Carolina Utilities Commission (“Commission”) that the Company will be filing its 2020 Evaluation, Measurement & Verification (“EM&V”) Report (“2020 EM&V Report”)¹ on May 15, 2020.

In recent years, the Company has filed its system-wide EM&V Report for approved demand-side management and energy efficiency (“DSM/EE”) programs on May 1 of each year. The May 1 EM&V Report filing date in North Carolina aligns with the current EM&V filing requirements in Virginia.² In support of the Company’s 2019 DSM/EE cost recovery rider, DENC witness Deanna Kessler represented the Company’s intent to file the 2020 EM&V Report on May 1, 2020, consistent with this past practice.³ Due to the ongoing State of Emergency in response to the COVID-19 pandemic⁴ and other considerations relevant to the timing of the 2020 EM&V Report filing in the
