Duke Energy Progress, LLC, ("DEP") and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("DEC") (collectively "Duke Energy" or "Companies"), pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-155(f), the North Carolina Utilities Commission's ("Commission") April 3, 2018 *Order Modifying And Approving Riders Implementing Solar Rebate Program* hereby notify the Commission that the 2021 participation caps for residential customers and non-residential customers under the Duke Energy Solar Rebate Program have been met for both DEP and DEC for the second capacity window of 2021. The participation limit for the second window of 2021 has not been reached for non-profit customers in DEC and DEP.

NOTIFICATION OF BIANNUAL PARTICIPATION LIMITS BEING REACHED

As directed by the Commission in its April 3, 2018 Order, Duke Energy hereby notifies the Commission that the biannual participation limits for residential customers and non-residential customers have been reached for both DEC and DEP, and the Companies' websites have been updated accordingly. These limits were reached after the random selection process following the close of random selection application period on July 14, 2021. A snapshot of the website informing the public of the rebate limits being reached is shown as Appendix A.

The Companies are continuing to accept applications for DEP and DEC non-profit customers, and the Companies will, in accordance with the Commission's April 3, 2018 Order, notify the Commission and update its website if the participation limit for non-profit customers is reached.

Appendix A

Important Notice

The residential and commercial participation limit for the July 2021 Solar Rebates Program has been reached. The rebate application will reopen on July 28, 2021 for nonprofit customers only. Duke Energy received a commission order changing some of the terms of the program. This enrollment period has the following changes:

- Rebate acceptance will move to a random selection process, instead of first come, first serve.
- Residential customers, who are accepted into the program, will receive 40 cents per watt, or \$4,000 maximum rebate.
- Commercial customers, who are accepted into the program, will receive 30 cents per watt, or \$30,000 maximum rebate.
- For the July 2021 enrollment period only, customers who installed their system from October 6, 2020 to January 6, 2021, are also eligible to apply.
- For the July 7 to July 14, 2021 enrollment period, customers who installed their systems on or after April 8, 2021 (90 days prior to July 7, 2021), would be eligible to apply at any time during that week.

Customer notifications and updates will be available on this page on July 27, 2021. If the participation limit for a specific customer class is not reached in the random allocation, the application process will be reopened for any group that has capacity available on July 28, 2021.
