ORDER CANCELING HEARING, DISMISSING COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE, AND CLOSING DOCKET

BY THE HEARING EXAMINER: On June 13, 2022, Rhett Tabor (Complainant) filed a complaint against Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (Defendant) in the above-captioned docket. On June 24, 2022, Defendant filed its Motion to Dismiss the Complaint. On October 10, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Granting Defendant's Motion to Dismiss, In Part, Denying Motion to Dismiss, In Part, and Scheduling Hearing. The order scheduled an evidentiary hearing on Complainant's remaining claims for Thursday, November 10, 2022, at 2:00 p.m. in Commission Hearing Room 2115, Dobbs Building, 430 North Salisbury Street, Raleigh, North Carolina.

After granting several motions for continuance, the Commission rescheduled the evidentiary hearing for Wednesday, October 11, 2023, at 2:00 p.m.

On September 8, 2023, Complainant filed a Notice of Voluntary Dismissal Without Prejudice.

The Hearing Examiner has reviewed the record and Complainant's notice and finds good cause to cancel the evidentiary hearing, dismiss the complaint, and close the docket in this matter.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That the evidentiary hearing scheduled for Wednesday, October 11, 2023, is hereby canceled; and

2. That the complaint is dismissed without prejudice and the docket is closed. ISSUED BY ORDER OF THE COMMISSION.
