BY THE CHAIR: On September 24, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Consolidating Dockets, Scheduling Hearings, Requiring Filing of Testimony, Establishing Procedural Guidelines, and Requiring Public Notice in the above captioned dockets. According to the schedule established in that order, Macadamia Solar, LLC, the Applicant in the dockets (Macadamia Solar or Applicant), may file rebuttal testimony on or before Tuesday, December 7, 2021.

On December 3, 2021, the Applicant filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Rebuttal Testimony and Exhibits. According to the Applicant, the parties have mutually agreed to provide additional time for discovery requests and responses, including an extension of the Public Staff's deadline for responses to data requests, until December 7, 2021. Due to this agreed upon extension, the Applicant requests an extension of time to file rebuttal testimony and exhibits until December 10, 2021.

Based upon the foregoing and the entire record herein, the Chair finds good cause to extend the deadline for the Applicant's rebuttal testimony and exhibits to December 10, 2021.
