BY THE CHAIR: On July 10, 2020, Warren K. Hicks and Christina D. Cress (Movants) filed a Motion for Substitution of Counsel in the above-captioned docket, pursuant to Commission Rules R1-7 and R1-23, and Rule 1.16(b) of the North Carolina Rules of Professional Conduct. Movants requested that the Commission enter an order allowing Ms. Hicks to withdraw from serving as the attorney of record for Carolina Industrial Group for Fair Utility Rates (CIGFUR), and that Ms. Cress be allowed to serve as the attorney of record for CIGFUR. Movants stated that Ms. Hicks has accepted employment as a senior staff attorney with the North Carolina Utilities Commission effective July 13, 2020, which precludes her from continuing to represent CIGFUR, and that Ms. Cress, Attorney at Law with the firm of Bailey & Dixon, LLP, will represent CIGFUR in this docket. Further, Movants stated that they provided notice to CIGFUR of Ms. Hick's withdrawal, and that they believe that her withdrawal can be accomplished without resulting in any material adverse effect on the interests of CIGFUR.

Based on the foregoing and the record herein, the Chair finds that there is justifiable cause to grant the Motion.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Warren K. Hicks is allowed to withdraw as counsel for CIGFUR, and Christina D. Cress is substituted as counsel for CIGFUR in the above-captioned docket.
