The Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission (Public Staff) respectfully submits this letter in lieu of reply comments in response to the North Carolina Utilities Commission’s (Commission) Order Establishing Proceeding and Requesting Comments in Docket No. E-100, Sub 101 (Order Requesting Comments).

The Commission issued its Order Requesting Comments on April 27, 2022.
