Request for Declaratory Ruling by Sunstone Energy Development, LLC

Dear Ms. Campbell:

On January 12, 2021, the North Carolina Utilities Commission (Commission) issued an Order Requesting Comments in the above-captioned docket, with petitions to intervene and initial comments to be filed on or before February 12, 2021 and reply comments on or before February 26, 2021. On February 5, 2021, Duke Energy Progress (DEP) filed a motion requesting that the date to file initial comments be extended to February 26, 2021, and for reply comments to March 12, 2021. On February 9, 2021, the Commission granted the request for extension. On February 26, 2021, the Public Staff filed a letter stating that it did not intend to file comments at this time.

On February 25, 2021, DEP filed a Motion to Dismiss for Failure to Meet Requirements of North Carolina Declaratory Judgement Act. On May 4, 2021, the Commission issued an Order denying DEP's Motion to Dismiss and established new deadlines for the filing of comments from interested parties, with petitions to intervene and initial comments to be filed on or before June 8, 2021 and reply comments on or before July 6, 2021.

The Public Staff, again, respectfully informs the Commission and the parties that we do not intend to file comments at this time.
