BY THE CHAIRMAN: On February 26, 2009, the Commission issued its Order Resolving Certain Issues, Requesting Information on Unsettled Matters, and Allowing Proposed Rider to become Effective Subject to Refund in the above-identified docket. That order required, among other things, that Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (Duke) file a proposed Notice to Customers.

On May 1, 2009, Duke filed a letter and a proposed Notice to Customers, stating that it had developed the proposed notice jointly with the Public Staff. Duke also stated that, because of a pending motion for reconsideration, Duke has elected to put into effect, subject to refund, only its conservation programs at this time. On May 7, 2009, Duke filed Revised Tariffs and Riders in this docket.


The Chairman finds good cause to approve Duke's Revised Tariffs and Riders and the proposed Notice to Customers as filed.
