	ORDER ISSUING
	AMENDED CERTIFICATE

BY THE COMMISSION: On December 15, 2015, the Commission issued an order granting Overman Solar, LLC (Applicant), a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the construction of a 5-MW<sub>AC</sub> solar photovoltaic (PV) electric generating facility to be located 191 Herring Road, Goldsboro, Wayne County, North Carolina, and accepting registration of the facility as a new renewable energy facility.

On December 20, 2018, the Applicant filed an amendment to its application, including a revised site plan map that expanded the facility's footprint.

On December 21, 2018, the Commission issued an Amended Order Requiring Publication of Notice.

On January 25, 2019, the Applicant filed a verified certificate of service stating that the application and the related public notice were provided to Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), on January 25, 2019.

On February 5, 2019, and February 25, 2019, the State Clearinghouse filed comments. The cover letters indicated that, because of the nature of the comments, no further State Clearinghouse review action by the Commission was required for compliance with the North Carolina Environmental Policy Act.

On February 8, 2019, at the request of the Public Staff, the Applicant filed a revised site plan map clarifying the locations of a number of features, including the interconnection facility and access road.

On July 2, 2019, the Applicant filed an additional verified certificate of service stating that the application and the related public notice were provided to DEP on June 24, 2019.

On September 9, 2019, the Applicant filed an affidavit of publication from the Goldsboro News-Argus, stating that the publication of notice was completed on July 16, 2019. No complaints have been received.

The Public Staff presented this matter to the Commission at its Regular Staff Conference on September 23, 2019. The Public Staff stated that it had reviewed the amended application and determined it to be in compliance with the requirements of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-110.1(a) and Commission Rule R8-64. Therefore, the Public Staff recommended approval of the amended certificate for the facility.

After careful consideration, the Commission finds good cause to approve the amended application and issue the attached amended certificate for the proposed solar PV electric generating facility.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That an amended certificate of public convenience and necessity shall be, and is hereby, issued to Overman Solar, LLC, for the construction of a 5-MW<sub>AC</sub> solar PV electric generating facility to be located 191 Herring Road, Goldsboro, Wayne County, North Carolina.

2. That Appendix A hereto shall constitute the amended certificate of public convenience and necessity issued for the facility.
