McNutt will continue to represent DoD/FEA in this proceeding until its final determination, and with reference to all matters incident to this proceeding, agrees to be subject to the orders and amenable to the disciplinary action and the civil jurisdiction of the General Court of Justice of the North Carolina State Bar in all respects as if Mr. McNutt were a regularly admitted and licensed member of the Bar of North Carolina in good standing.





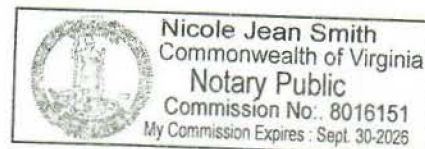
