
Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("Duke Energy Carolinas" or "Company") hereby moves the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission"), for an order granting an extension of time from February 24, 2011 to March 1, 2011 for the parties to file reply comments in this docket. In support of this motion, the Company respectfully shows the Commission the following:

1. Commission Rule R8-60 requires that "[w]ithin 14 days after the filing of initial comments, the parties may file reply comments addressing any substantive or procedural issue raised by any other party." Pursuant to the Commission's *Order Granting Motion for Extension of Time*, issued in this docket on January 19, 2011, the Public Staff and other intervenors filed their respective comments on the integrated resource plans of the North Carolina electric power suppliers on February 10, 2011.
2. The Company is in the process of preparing its reply comments, however it will need additional time to complete its filing due to workload difficulties arising from other matters and the unavailability of the Company's integrated resource planning personnel due to conflicting travel schedules;
3. Duke Energy Carolinas will be unable to complete its reply comments within the fourteen (14) day timeframe under the Rules and requests an extension until March 1, 2011 to complete its filing; and

4. The Company has consulted with all other parties participating in this docket and no party has objected to the extension request.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, respectfully requests that the Commission extend the deadline for submission of reply comments in this docket from February 24, 2011 to March 1, 2011.


