Re: What are rider adjustments as related to the Summary of Rider Adjustments on my bill

To Whom It May Concern:

I do not recall ever hearing anything on TV or getting any mail warning me that I could have such an exorbitant amount suddenly added to my electric bill. The first time I recall seeing such a charge was on or around my October 2023 bill. I actually did not pay much attention because I am so use to additions to Duke Energy bill and generally the amounts are not high enough to make or break us until NOW! On my January bill, there was an additional amount of \$50.76 added to my bill, the most of that being from "rider adjustments".

I assume these rider adjustments are calculated by the number of kwh used, and if I am correct, in January these additional charges amounted to almost **one-fourth of what my basic+usage charge**. I see an addition of this amount as a real injustice to the Duke Energy customers.

My husband and I live on just our Social Security checks. I admit it probably is not practical to have electric heat, but we do not have the funds to change our heat source. So, we do everything we can to conserve energy for the purpose of being able to pay the electric bill. I read our meter every other day so I will know where we are during the course of a month. I am very disheartened and discouraged that all my efforts to conserve were blown away by this extra charge of \$50.76 – especially the part caused by the "summary of rider adjustments".

Please tell me (1) what is a rider adjustment and I assume the answer to that will give me the answer to question #2 which is:

(2) exactly what is that money used for

(3) is it an additional charge that will exist for a temporary period of time or will it be on the bill for the rest of eternity?
