BY THE CHAIR: On August 23, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Requesting Comments in the above-captioned dockets on the request by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (collectively Duke), for approval of their proposed Customer Operated Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE) tariff. Comments and reply comments are presently due to be filed on September 21, 2022, and October 5, 2022, respectively.

On September 13, 2022, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that the Commission extend the time for filing comments and reply comments on the EVSE tariff to November 21, 2022, and December 5, 2022, respectively. The Public Staff stated that due to the press of other business, and particularly its involvement in the Duke Carbon Plan hearings in Docket No. E-100, Sub 179, the Public Staff needs additional time to prepare and file its comments. The Public Staff further stated that it had conferred with Duke, and that Duke has no objection to the requested extension of time.

Based on the foregoing and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend the dates for filing comments and reply comments on Duke's proposed EVSE tariff to November 21, 2022, and December 5, 2022, respectively, for all parties.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
