NOW COME Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, Duke Energy Progress, LLC (collectively, the "Companies") and the Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Public Staff") (collectively with the Companies, the "Movants"), pursuant to Rule R1-7 of the North Carolina Utilities Commission's (the "Commission") Rules and Regulations, and respectfully move for a fourteen-day extension of time to file the Final Report of the Low Income Affordability Collaborative (the "Collaborative Final Report" or the "Report") in the above-captioned dockets. In support of this motion, the Movants show the following:

- 1. The Commission in its April 16, 2021 Order Accepting Stipulations, Granting Partial Rate Increase and Requiring Customer Notice in Docket Nos. E-2, Sub 1219 and Sub 1193 and its March 31, 2021 Order Accepting Stipulations, Granting Partial Rate Increase, and Requiring Customer Notice in Docket Nos. E-7, Sub 1213, Sub 1214, and Sub 1187 ("Rate Case Orders") established the Low-Income Affordability Collaborative and required that the Companies and the Public Staff file the joint Collaborative Final Report within 12 months of the Collaborative's first workshop; the Report is due July 29, 2022.
- 2. The Companies and the Public Staff have been working diligently to prepare the Collaborative Final Report but need additional time to complete the Report. Accordingly, the Movants request a fourteen (14) day extension of time, until and including August 12, 2022, to file the Report.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission issue an order extending the time to file the Collaborative Final Report to August 12, 2022, and such other relief as the Commission deems just and proper.
