BY THE CHAIR: On June 20, 2019, the Commission issued an Order scheduling the above-captioned matter for hearing on Monday, September 9, 2019.

On September 5, 2019, Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), and the Public Staff (collectively, Movants) filed separate motions requesting that the Commission excuse several witnesses from attending the hearing. DEP requested that witnesses Regis Repko, Kenneth D. Church, and Kelvin Henderson be excused, and the Public Staff requested that Dustin R. Metz and Jenny X. Li be excused. Movants stated that all parties in this docket have agreed to waive cross-examination of these witnesses, and offer no objection to the introduction of the witnesses' testimony and exhibits into the record.


